

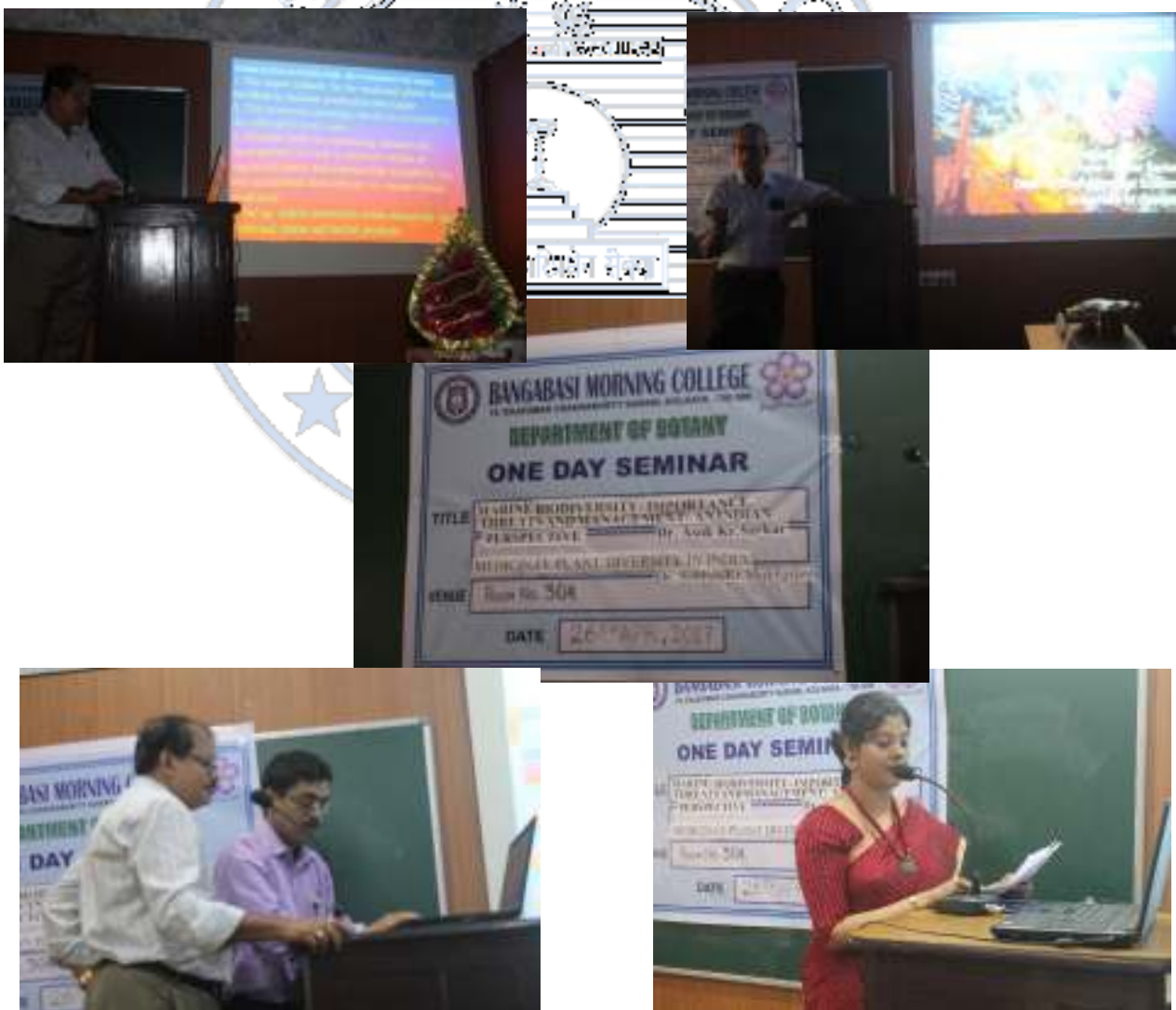


3.1.3 Number of Seminars/conferences/workshops conducted by the institution during the year

Report of the events during last 5 years

Department of Botany

1. A one day seminar on “Environment Protection” was organized by the Department of Botany, Bangabasi Morning College, on 26th April 2017 at the smart classroom of the college premise. The event was chaired by Prof. Shipra Halder, Teacher-In-Charge, Bangabasi Morning College, and attended by teachers from different departments. Eminent scientist and teachers from the field of life sciences delivered their enlightening lectures, enriching the students about the nature and the need to protect the environment. All students from Botany department and many students from other Bioscience departments participated in the event.





2. A one-day seminar on “Advances in Plant Sciences” was organized by the Department of Botany, Bangabasi Morning College, on 22nd September 2017 at the smart classroom of the college premise. The event was chaired by Prof. Shipra Halder, Teacher-In-Charge, Bangabasi Morning College, and attended by teachers from different departments. Eminent scientist and teachers from the field of plant science delivered their enlightening lectures, informing the students about the current trends in plant science. All students from Botany department and many students from other Bioscience departments participated in the event.

Four eminent scientists from Universities and Research Institutes were invited to deliver lectures in the seminar. The scientists delivered IEL on their research activities. The names of the scientists were:

1. Prof. Chittaranjan Saha, Department of Chemistry, Indian University. He gave talk on "The Chemist: Bonding Concept: Foundation of Drug Design".
2. Prof. Sambhu Ghosh Deb, Department of Bio-organic Chemistry, Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science. He delivered lecture on "Alzheimer's Disease: A Home Perspective".
3. Prof. Swagata Dasgupta, Department of Chemistry, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur. The topic of her lecture was "The wonderful World of Protein Structure and Interactions".
4. Prof. Anup Kumar Mishra, Division of Molecular Modeling, Bose Institute. He gave talk on "Isolation, Identification and Analysis of Medicinally Important Compounds from Plants".

Quite large number students were present in the seminar. Faculty members from different colleges also attended.

Due to rapid growth of the subject, it has become difficult for an individual to keep abreast of the latest developments. We hope that the informative deliberations from the eminent scientists and mutual exchange of ideas benefited our students and all the participants.





Department of Commerce.

7. The Commerce Department, Bangabasi Morning College had organized a seminar on “GST: The road ahead” on 18th September, 2017 for the benefit of the students. As GST happened to be the newly introduced topic by the Government then, it was included in the undergraduate syllabus by the University of Calcutta as well. Therefore, the particular topic was selected to know about the new rules and regulations in GST. 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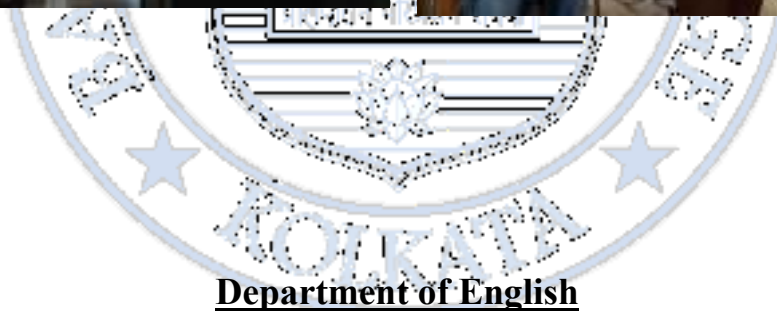
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on the topic. He explained all the aspects of demonetization in India with different examples taking from daily life. He also explained the impact of demonetization on the Indian economy, the success, failure etc.

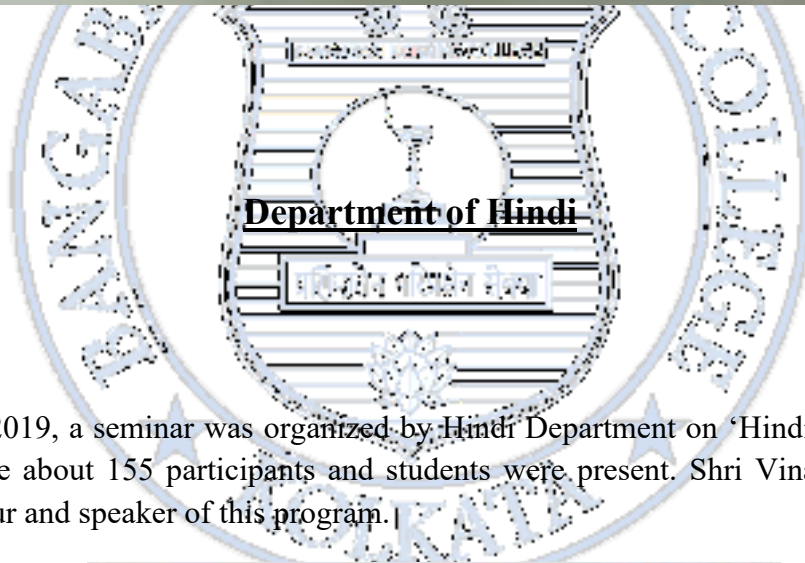

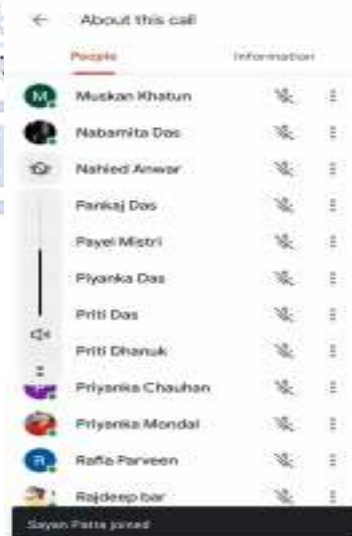
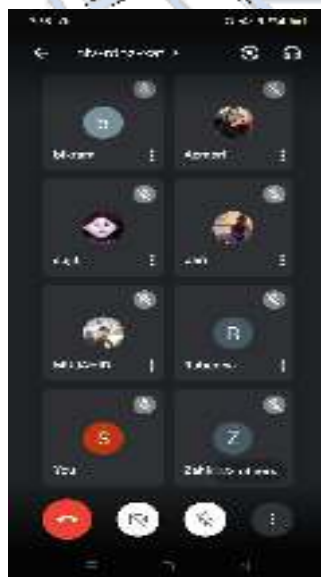
Mughal Mansabdari System
