

## **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Love Without Boundaries and Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit**



This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 by and between Love Without Boundaries (hereinafter referred to as "LWB"), a non-profit charitable organization registered under [CIT(EXMPTION),KOLKATA/12AA/2020-21/A/10582], and Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit (hereinafter referred to as "College"), a renowned institution with its principal office located at 19 Rajkumar Chakraborty Sarani, Kolkata 700009.

### **Background:**

LWB is dedicated to improving the lives of orphaned and vulnerable children across the globe through various educational, health, and community development programs. Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit, with its commitment to academic excellence and social responsibility, seeks to contribute positively to society through its educational initiatives.

### **Purpose:**

This MoU outlines the terms and conditions of collaboration between LWB and Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit for the implementation of the Youth for Kids (Y4K) initiative. The collaboration aims to empower students, foster community engagement, and create a lasting impact on the lives of orphaned and vulnerable children.

### **Scope of Collaboration:**

1. Both parties agree to collaborate on the Y4K initiative, focusing on areas including child trafficking reduction, school dropout prevention, health and nutrition, child education engagement, and community service.

2. Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit will establish and maintain a Y4K chapter on its campus, engaging its students in Y4K activities and projects.
3. LWB will provide guidance, project materials, and resources required for the successful execution of Y4K projects.
4. Both parties will actively participate in organizing awareness campaigns, educational workshops, and community service events.

**Duration:**

This collaboration will commence on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 and will continue for a period of three years, with the Y4K projects running for a duration of four months.

**Financial Commitment:**

There will be no financial transaction and no clash of interests.

**Project Milestones:**

- 1) Conducting Initial Needs Assessment: Both parties will collaborate to assess the needs and challenges of target communities.
- 2) Awareness Campaigns: Jointly organizing campaigns to raise awareness about child trafficking, school dropout prevention, and related issues.
- 3) Education Programs: Designing and implementing education programs, including fundraising initiatives and education center visits.
- 4) Community Engagement: Organizing workshops, events, and campaigns to benefit local communities.
- 5) Impact Assessment: Regularly evaluating project outcomes and reflecting on their impact.

**Role of Mentor:**

A designated teacher from Bangabasi Morning College, NSS Unit will also play the role of a mentor in the Y4K project, guiding and supporting student volunteers in their endeavors.



**Confidentiality:**

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any sensitive information exchanged during the course of this collaboration.

**Child Protection Policy :**

All volunteers should abide with the United Nations Conventions on the Right of a Child. (UNCRC)

**● Dos:**

Child's Best Interests: Always prioritize the child's best interests.

Respect and Dignity: Treat every child with respect and dignity.

Child-Centered Approach: Keep the child at the center of your work.

Safeguarding: Ensure adequate safeguarding measures are in place.

Listen Actively: Be an active listener and take children's concerns seriously.

Privacy and Confidentiality: Respect privacy and confidentiality.

Training and Awareness: Stay informed and undergo relevant training.

Collaboration: Collaborate with others for comprehensive support.

**● Don'ts:**

Abuse or Neglect: Never subject children to abuse or neglect.

Exploitation: Do not exploit children for any gain.

Discrimination: Do not discriminate against children.

Violation of Privacy: Respect their privacy.

Unauthorized Disclosure: Do not disclose sensitive information without consent.

Ignoring Signs of Distress: Pay attention to signs of distress or harm.

Isolation: Avoid isolating children, except when necessary for safety.

Lack of Training: Do not work without proper training.

Ignoring Child's Voice: Consider the child's opinions and concerns.

Failure to Report: Report suspected abuse or exploitation promptly

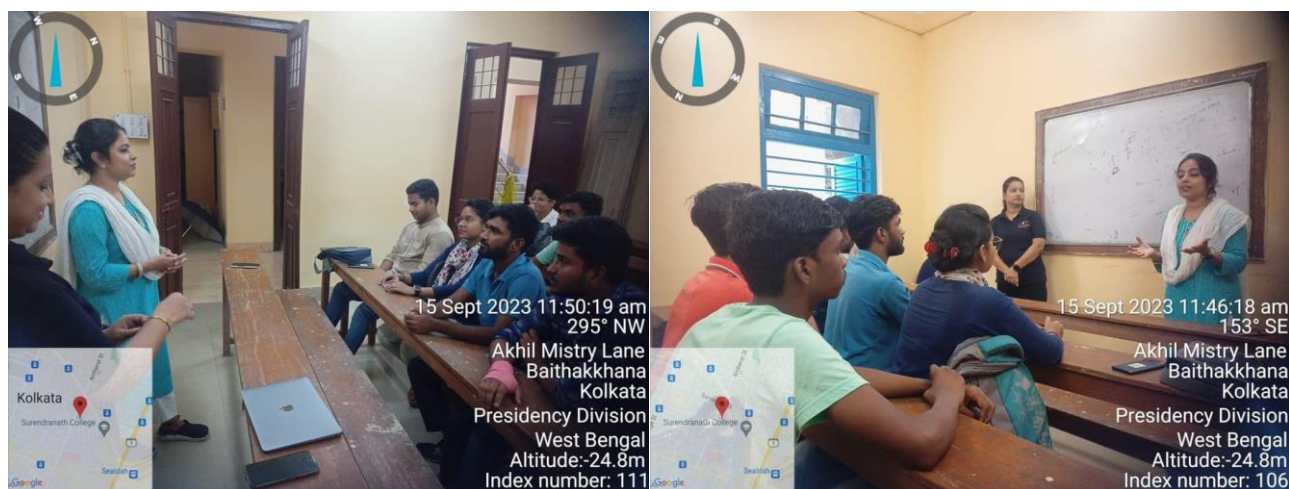
