AND

THE ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION SOCIETY (SWITCHON FOUNDATION)

29th February, 2024

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this the 29th February, 2024 at Kolkata, West Bengal

BETWEEN

Bangabasi Morning College having its campus at 19 Rajkumar Chakraborty Sarani, Kolkata-9 hereinafter referred to as the "COLLEGE", represented by Dr. Amitava Dutta, Principal as the (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors-in-office, administrators, executors, legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART.

AND

Environment Conservation Society (SwitchON Foundation), Address: Jaju Bhawan, Debendra Lal Khan Rd, Sector I, Bhowanipore, Kolkata, West Bengal 700027, represented by its DGM-Operations CASC, namely **Mr. Uddip Nandi**, hereinafter referred to as "Partner" (which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators and assigns) of the **SECOND PART.**

First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party'

WHEREAS:

 A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named Bangabasi Morning College, 19 Rajkumar Chakraborty Sarani, Kolkata-9

- B) the SECOND PARTY herein is Environment Conservation Society (SwitchON Foundation) a leading not for profit, established in 2008, working in the space of Renewable Energy Access, Sustainable Agriculture/Livelihoods and Skilling Education
- C) the SECOND PARTY's initiative of Clean Air and Sustainable Cities programme, supported by the Department of Power, Government of West Bengal to create an ecosystem for green entrepreneurship in Bengal.

Clean Air & Sustainable Cities

In 2010, the Clean Air and Sustainable Communities (CASC) initiative took root as a distinctive program under the umbrella of the SwitchON Foundation. The primary aim of CASC is to promote inclusive public participation, contribute to informed policymaking, and foster collaboration with government authorities. Its overarching mission is to expedite awareness initiatives targeting children, youth, and civil society on crucial issues such as Air Pollution and Climate Change.

Under the stewardship of SwitchON, the Clean Air Championship Networks have been successfully instituted in more than 150 schools, complemented by the establishment of 13 Clean Air Networks spanning the regions of West Bengal, Jharkhand, and Odisha. These endeavors are made possible through strategic partnerships with esteemed governmental and non-governmental organizations, including WBPCB, JPCB, OPCB, CES, Earth Day Network, WWF, and Energy Swaraj Foundation. Together, these collaborations work harmoniously to elevate awareness and inspire positive actions for cleaner air in the community.

Meaning and significance of CASC Members

CASC Network Members comprise academic institutions, incubators, university entrepreneur programs, technology parks, private non-profits, and private for-profits. The form of the member organization will be dependent on what interested parties are available in each region. Ideally, the CASC Member will be a well-established incubator/innovation center that can administer the CASC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED THAT:

FIRST PARTY AND SECOND PARTY will engage in good faith to create an entrepreneurial culture in the state of West Bengal through the following mutually agreed upon initiatives and interventions.

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Assessing the needs of the and opportunities and developing customized solutions in meeting these needs;
- 1.2 Provide programming (framework and content) developed by the CASC to the Institute at no/low cost;
- 1.3 Sharing best practices with the Institute thus making it more effective in the most cost-efficient manner;
- 1.4 Starting a Green Bengal Innovation Movement and involving the Institute in showcasing their activities and initiatives pertaining to innovation and entrepreneurship in the green sector.
- 1.5 The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties in joint consultation. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 1.6 Both parties herein can jointly / individually provide a certificate along with joint signature to the trainee students of First Party.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 Skill Training in the form of Workshop or Certificate Course: The SECOND PARTY will provide skill development and entrepreneurship development Training Programs for the trainee students of FIRST PARTY and vice-versa at no cost.

Student groups will be provided by the **FIRST PARTY** to participate in activities, events, and competitions organized by the **SECOND PARTY** with prior mutual consent.

2.2 FIRST PARTY may organize events with the assistance of SECOND PARTY on a prior approval basis. As part of the relationship, the FIRST PARTY will support the SECOND PARTY with their faculties and personnel as an event expert, speaker, etc. with travel expenses given to them by the SECOND PARTY.

2.3 The **FIRST PARTY** will provide support in making training modules in sustainable thematic areas for the **SECOND PARTY**. The **FIRST PARTY** will assist/support the **SECOND PARTY** in creating training modules and provide trainers based on sustainable themes.

2.4 The SECOND PARTY will provide the FIRST PARTY at least one short-term live project per year on any CASC-related theme conducted at the FIRST PARTY's campus. Under any circumstances., the said project's estimated cost shall not exceed INR 15,000 and will be provided by the SECOND PARTY only. Before the allocation of funds, the live projects will be examined and approved by the SECOND PARTY.

2.5 Every year, the **FIRST PARTY** will organize at least one event on green entrepreneurship theme aligned with the **FIRST PARTY's** event list, wherein the **SECOND PARTY** will participate as a guest only. The **SECOND PARTY** will support the development and formation of a student representative body and student ambassador on campus. The **FIRST PARTY** will be in charge of maintaining and providing guidance assistance for the program's smooth running by the **SECOND PARTY**.

2.6 The **FIRST PARTY** will support the **SECOND PARTY** by providing their auditorium/college campus as venue of event on GBN related thematic area

2.7 The FIRST PARTY shall extend its support to the SECOND PARTY by offering its faculty members as resource persons when requested by the SECOND PARTY. Conversely, the SECOND PARTY shall reciprocate by facilitating the provision of resource persons to the FIRST PARTY whenever the FIRST PARTY hosts any event or webinar.

2.8 The parties herein will share regular feedback to each other in terms of the lessons learnt and provide necessary resources to achieve the goals of the partnership; respect good business practices by operating transparently, putting in place measures to assure the maximum possible environmental and business practices, and offering high standards of quality, redress and transparency to end users.

2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of **Bangabasi Morning College**, the first party to take up any program mentioned in MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

2.10 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required.

Terms of Agreement

- This agreement shall come into force and bind the Parties hereto from the day it is executed.
- This agreement shall continue to be in full force and effect for a period of twelve (12) months, starting from the date of commencement of joint activities.
- The Parties agree to keep confidential the existence and content of this Agreement, as well as any information exchanges between the Parties that is expressly indicated to be confidential.

Agreement

The undersigned agree to the above terms to work together in establishing a successful and sustainable project.

The partnership can be terminated within one (1) month by either party at any time, with notice given in writing (email included) to all other parties, and one (1) month allowed for dispute resolution.
