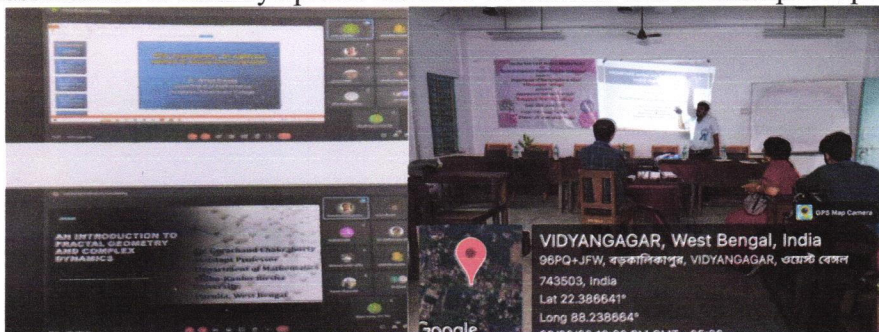

3.2.2 Number of Seminars/ conferences/ workshops conducted by the institution during last five years

Report of the events during last five years (June, 2023- July, 2018)

1. Department of Mathematics and IQAC, Bangabasi Morning College and Department of Mathematics and IQAC of Vidyanagar College jointly organised a **One Day State-Level Seminar (Blended Mode) on Recent development in Mathematics and its Application** on 30th June, 2023. The programme started with a welcome address by the Principals of two Colleges, Dr. Amitava Dutta and Dr. S.P Agarwala. Dr. Gorachand Chakraborty, Professor, Dept of Mathematics, Sidho Kanho Birsha Unversity and Dr. Amiya Biswas, Assistant Professor, Dept of Mathematics, Durgapur Government College delivered their speech in online mode and Prof. Md Mahatab Uddin Molla, Assistant Professor, Dept of Mathematics, Bangabasi Morning College delivered his speech through offline mode at Vidyanagar College. All the teachers and students who participated in the seminar were glad to hear valuable lectures about this topic from all speakers. As a result of this seminar they can visualized the application of Euclidean and Non-Euclidean Geometry, also learned how to secure communication using algebraic method, moreover also got to know how to use fuzzy set in classification of same symptoms diseases. 72 students and teachers participated in this seminar.



2. A student seminar (for Semester VI) was organized by the Department of Anthropology, Bangabasi Morning College, on 23.06.2023 at the Class room (No. 304B) of the college. Title of the seminar was **“Adolescent food Habits (beyond tradition)”**.
